DOUGLAS ROAD/GRANT LINE ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

PROJECT TITLE: Douglas Road and Grant Line Road Intersection Improvements Project

PROJECT LOCATION: The proposed project is located at the intersection of Douglas Road and Grant Line Road and along Douglas Road and Grant Line Road approaching the intersection in eastern Rancho Cordova.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The City of Rancho Cordova Public Works Department proposes to install a new traffic signal at the intersection of Douglas Road and Grant Line Road. The project will also include widening of Douglas Road and Grant Line Road approaching the intersection to accommodate left-turn and right-turn pockets and bicycle lanes. The project will require right-of-way acquisition for the widening of Douglas Road.

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: A **30** day public review period for the draft Mitigated Negative Declaration will commence on **March 30, 2015** through **April 28, 2015** for interested individuals and public agencies to submit written comments on the document. Any written comments on the draft Mitigated Negative Declaration must be received at the above physical address or e-mail address within the public review period.
