



MATHER VETERANS VILLAGE



Built in three phases, Mather Veterans Village (MVV) provides formerly homeless and/or disabled veterans a place to call home. The community provides a total of 100 permanent supportive homes for veterans in Phases I and III, and 47 beds of transitional housing in Phase II. MVV is situated on the former Mather Air Force Base and is one block from the hub of Northern California Veterans Administration Medical Center.

Mercy Housing California and Nation's Finest have partnered with the Veterans Administration to provide comprehensive services and case management centered around mental health, employment support, and community building. MVV's campus also includes a community garden, outdoor courtyards and recreation space, laundry facilities, as well as a mess hall with a full commercial kitchen in Phase II.

- Phase III: 44 one-bedroom and 6 two-bedroom apartments
