- The primary emissions sources and activities in Rancho Cordova that are expected to generate climate-warming GHG emissions in the future
- The role that State and federal actions play in reducing emissions in Rancho Cordova
- How much lower the city's future emissions need to be to meet California's climate goals

Background on Rancho Cordova's Climate Action Plan (CAP)

This public workshop is one in a series that will be conducted at various stages of the CAP. The purpose of the CAP is to:

- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions generated in the city
- Set emission reduction targets to align with the State of California's GHG reduction goals
- Establish polices and actions to reach reduction targets
