CERTIFICATION INFORMATION

*All recyclable and/or compostable/organic materials generated at this business are (check all that apply):

- Self-hauled: "Self-haul," means a covered generator or designated employee who collects, transports, and hauls recyclable materials and/or organic recyclable materials from the business or multifamily residential property to a recycling facility rather than hiring a franchised waste hauler to perform this function.
- Back-hauled: "Back-haul" means generating and transporting recyclable materials and/or organic waste to a destination owned and operated by the generator using the generator's own employees and equipment.

Recyclable materials include paper (newspaper, magazines, cardboard, junk mail), beverage containers (glass and aluminum), scrap metal, and rigid plastic containers (#1 PET and #2 HDPE). **Compostable/organic materials** include yard trimmings (grass, weeds, leaves, prunings, branches, dead plants, brush, tree trimmings, dead trees, small clean wood pieces), and food scraps (vegetable waste, fruit waste, dairy waste, meat waste, fish waste, and food-soiled paper products).

REQUIRED SELF-HAUL INFORMATION

All compostable and/or recyclable materials are self-hauled by employee(s) of the business to a composting or recycling facility. State and local laws require businesses to keep a record of the amount of materials recycled/composted. Records must include delivery receipts and weight tickets with amounts in cubic yards or tons with the name of the recycling or composting facility clearly shown on receipts. The record is subject to inspection, if requested. **Documentation must be submitted to the city annually in order to renew the self-haul exemption.** Receipts from two recent transactions must be submitted with the completed form.
