PROJECT TITLE: Sphere of Influence (SOI) Annexation and Prezoning

PROJECT LOCATION: The annexation area consists of approximately 748 acres of land equal

to the City's existing Sphere of Influence. The annexation area is located adjacent to the northeastern portion of the City of Rancho Cordova, in eastern Sacramento County. The annexation area is bounded by Sunrise Boulevard to the west, Highway 50 to the north, Hazel Avenue to the east, and portions of Sanders Drive, Gold Valley Drive, and White Rock Road to the south, as well as portions of the Folsom South Canal

to the south and east.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Annexation of the area to the City of Rancho Cordova would transfer land

use authority for the area to the City, replacing Sacramento County planning and zoning designations. There are no physical improvements or construction activities proposed by the annexation itself, at this time. Future actions and development within the annexation area would be subject to additional environmental review on a project-by-project basis.

FINDINGS/DETERMINATION: The City has reviewed and considered the proposed project and has

determined that the project will <u>not</u> have a significant effect on the environment, with substantial supporting evidence provided in the Initial Study. The City hereby prepares and proposes to adopt a **Negative**

Declaration for this project.

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: A 30 day public review period for the Initial Study/Negative Declaration

will commence on February 23, 2007 and will end on March 26, 2007 for interested individuals and public agencies to submit written comments on the document.
