NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION/INITIAL STUDY FOR MONTELENA, PROJECT #RC 04-132

PROJECT TITLE: Montelena

PROJECT LOCATION: The Montelena project site is located within the approved Sunrise Douglas Community Plan and Sunridge Specific Plan (SDCP/SRSP) areas on the southwest corner of Douglas Road and Jaeger Road. The project site is generally bounded by the Jaeger Road to the east, the Anatolia I subdivision to the west, Douglas Road to the north, and the Anatolia II subdivision to the south.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Montelena project comprises 251.9 acres and proposes the construction of 874 dwelling units (du) on 143.9 acres. The proposed project also includes five neighborhood park parcels on 20.1 acres, a detention basin on 9.6 acres, fire station on 2.7 acres and a wetland preserve on 54.5 acres.

FINDINGS/DETERMINATION: The City has reviewed and considered the proposed project and has determined that the project will <u>not</u> have a significant effect on the environment, with substantial supporting evidence provided in the Initial Study. The City hereby prepares and proposes to adopt a **Mitigated Negative Declaration** for this project.

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: A 30 day public review period for the Mitigated Negative Declaration/Initial Study will commence on **May 27, 2005 through June 27, 2005** for interested individuals and public agencies to submit written comments on the document. Any written comments on the Mitigated Negative Declaration/Initial Study must be received at the above address within the public review period. Copies of the Mitigated Negative Declaration/Initial Study are available for review at the above address.

PUBLIC MEETING: This project has not been scheduled for the City of Rancho Cordova Planning Commission and City Council.
